GCV Action Fund highlights records of GOP contenders

"The Environment isn't Just for Democrats," says [www.stopwaynehill.com](http://www.stopwaynehill.com). "Republican President Teddy Roosevelt was the first prominent conservationist and instituted the system of National Parks and Forests."

"Bobby Reese has shown that Republicans care about conservation issues. His work on protecting trout streams is an example of Republicans reclaiming the heritage of Teddy Roosevelt. This is not some Atlanta Special Interest group coming in trying to tell voters in Gwinnett County how to live their lives."

"We have a successful track record of working with various interest groups such as The Garden Clubs of Georgia and the Camo Coalition. Now we are partnering with the homeowner advocates who have become a major force in Republican politics in Gwinnett County," said Rooks.
